Located 'on the rise' adjoining the eastern boundary of Stage 4, this new release is well located, adjacent to the future central reserve and only a short walk to the existing lineal reserve and waterway. Once Mortimer Street is extended further south, this stage will be even closer to the town with only a short walk up Mortimer Street to Aldi or the proposed Coles next door.

### The Bellarine Rail Trail

Drysdale is almost exactly the mid point of the 35km length of the rail trail which runs from South Geelong through Drysdale to Queenscliff.

The Bellarine Railway operates a heritage train service almost every Sunday between Queenscliff and Drysdale, with A Day out with Thomas and Friends a popular school holiday attraction for the kids. For the bigger kids (ie adults), The famous Blues Train runs on Saturday nights from August to May and is a 'must do' experience for music aficionados.

The other real advantage of Stage 5 is that most of the blocks are either flat or have very limited fall making the job for the builders that much easier (and not to mention cheaper).

The trail itself is also very popular with cyclists, runners and walkers alike. The 17km from Drysdale to Queenscliff is a crushed rock path, which is slightly downhill, with Shelter and toilets at Suma Park (a little over half way) and has sections with some remnant indigenous vegetation within the wider trail reserve.
